Hi everyone,

We hope you have had a relaxing holiday and had the opportunity to get away, see friends and family or get a project done.

You may have heard the announcement yesterday afternoon from the Deputy Premier, James Merlino. The Department of Education and Training has provided guidelines for a staggered return of students to school in Regional Victoria. In order to meet the needs of the students in our school, we have the following plan for on-site learning:

- Year 12 VCE and VCAL students will return to on-site learning on Monday 4th October, with COVID safety measures in place.
- Year 11 students completing a Unit 3/4 subject will be able to come on-site for these classes as of Monday 4th October, with COVID safety measures in place. They will continue with Remote and Flexible Learning for their other subjects.
- Year 7 to 11 students will begin the term on Monday 4th October with Remote and Flexible Learning, and have a staggered return to school that will be as follows:
 - Year 11 students will return to on-site learning on a full-time basis as of Wednesday 6th
 October.
 - Year 7 students will return to on-site learning on a full-time basis as of Monday 11th
 October.
 - Year 8, 9 and 10 students will return to on-site learning in the following stages:
 - Year 8 students will attend on-site lessons for two days (possibly Tuesdays and Wednesdays) in Weeks 2 and 3, continuing with remote learning on the other days.
 - Year 9 and 10 students will attend on-site lessons for two days (possibly Thursdays and Fridays) in Weeks 2 and 3, continuing with remote learning on the other days.
 - Year 8, 9 and 10 students will return to on-site learning on a full-time basis as of Tuesday 26th October.

Please note: the <u>specific days</u> of the week on-site may change for Year 8, 9 and 10 students due to complex timetabling issues that we are working through, however, the students will be on-site for the number of days stated above. The information above gives a guide for returning on-site. We will confirm the specific days as soon as possible.


