### Notes on the Senior Studies Program:

- Features of our Senior Studies Program are flexibility and the tailoring of courses to individual students.
- The VCE program in any year is determined largely by student demand. The subjects listed above have run during recent years, although not all are currently running. A small number of subjects are offered by Distance Education and via the Wimmera Virtual Schools Project.
- Although not shown on the above grid, over the past couple of years, approximately half of our senior students have undertaken VCAL. These students study VCE English, a Mathematics and one other VCE subject, as well as Personal Development and Work Related Skills. In addition, they have a one-day work placement. Some students gain both a VCE and VCAL certificate.
- Also not shown above is that both VCE and VCAL students have access to a large range of VET programs offered by the Ballarat VET cluster.
